Position Title: Solid Waste Utility Worker/Equipment Operator "C"

Reports To: Works & Operations Manager

Position Description: To collect and handle solid waste generated by the residential

and business sectors, assist Works & Operations as an equipment operator or airport operator as necessary.

Responsibilities:

 Performs functions associated with collecting and handling solid waste, including operating the garbage truck and disposing of the solid waste following all environmental guidelines

- Performs general labour duties including assisting roadway maintenance crew, moving of construction materials, janitorial duties, and washing and cleaning vehicles
- 3. Operates most of the equipment in the department, including the loaders, 5 ton dump, garbage truck, sander, trackless, asphalt reclaimer and steamer as required
- 4. Assists with the operation of sewer equipment, water thawing machine and steamer as required
- 5. Performs minor repairs on heavy-duty equipment including oil and fluid level checks, greasing, checking for loose nozzles and small leaks, assisting to replace cutting edges and washing of equipment
- 6. Performs airport operator duties as required including: ensuring the airport operation is maintained efficiently and safely following all federal, provincial, and municipal regulations; maintaining airport grounds and buildings for safety and aesthetic reasons; dispensing fuel to aircrafts and maintaining fuel dispensing equipment as required; ensuring fuel, supplies, major servicing and/or repairs are adequate; recording information and preparing reports (fuel sales and invoicing, traffic/passenger activity, weather condition information, grounds and/or building maintenance); and, responding to after-hour call outs to provide fuel and/or airport conditions for flights
- 7. Works in a safe manner in accordance with the Occupational Health & Safety Act and Regulations
- 8. Performs other duties as required from time to time

- Minimum 200 operating hours on the loader, 5 ton dump and garbage trucks
- Valid DZ class licence (and ability to operate heavy equipment on occasion)
- Working knowledge of sewer equipment, water thawing machine, trackless asphalt reclaimer and steamer
- Valid "AZ" driver's licence considered an asset or willing to obtain
- Valid standard first aid certificate
- Willing to work in inclement weather and in a team setting
- General knowledge of radio communication systems
- Ability to perform minor maintenance repairs on mobile equipment, runway lights, etc.
