## Responsibilities:

1. Performs general parks and green space maintenance including turf management, removing garbage and debris, clearing and trimming brush and trees, and inspecting and maintaining parks, playgrounds and playground equipment.

- 2. Performs arena, pool and complex maintenance including ice and ice plant maintenance, pool and filter room maintenance, general housekeeping and janitorial tasks.
- 3. Performs daily inspections of all facilities' mechanical systems, enters results in log books, and reports any problems immediately.
- 4. Ensures, that by operating the appropriate equipment, the facility and grounds are maintained in a safe condition. Performs a circle check of any equipment before it is placed into service.
- 5. In the absence of a Recreation Operator, coordinates emergency building or grounds evacuations per policy and procedures and inspects evacuation equipment and first aid supplies regularly and replaces as necessary.
- 6. Insures all snow or debris is removed from all facility exit doors, keeps all maintenance and lunch areas in a clean and tidy condition, and ensures facility buildings, grounds and equipment are properly secured at the end of each shift. Ensures municipally-owned tools are maintained, properly stored and accounted for.
- 7. Liaises with facility patrons and provides excellent customer service on behalf of the Employer.
- 8. In the absence of a Recreation Operator, assists in coordinating the scheduling, training, supervising and completing of evaluations of student employees.

- 9. Works in a safe manner in accordance with the Occupational Health & Safety Act and Regulations and safe operating procedures. In the absence of a Recreation Operator, ensures all staff are regularly made aware of any unsafe practices and ensures compliance by corrective action as necessary.
- 10. Performs any other duties as required

## Qualifications:

- Minimum of grade 12 and 1 year of experience in a related field
- Able to train, supervise and motivate student employees
- Ability to perform rotating shifts to fulfil the requirements of a seven-day a week operation and ability to work overtime on short notice
- Physically able to perform all activities required within this department (i.e., lifting, climbing, digging, working at heights, etc.)
- Demonstrates capability of operating hand tools and small equipment (lawn mower, snow blower, chain saw, etc.)
- Basic building maintenance skills including routine carpentry and plumbing
- Capable of working in inclement weather and in a team setting
- Demonstrates the ability to communicate effectively with the public and co-workers, handle concerns and complaints in an effective manner, plan and complete work in an efficient self-motivating manner, and perform with minimal supervision
- Holds a valid Class "G" driver's license and good driving record
- Holds a valid standard first aid certificate, WHMIS Certificate, Chainsaw Certification and Basic Fall Arrest training
- Basic Refrigeration, Safe Ice Resurfacer, Turf Management, Aquatic Facilities Operations certifications or equivalent experience a definite asset
- Provide a vulnerable sector check satisfactory to the Employer
